



Situated in Walker Township, Centre County. Originally surveyed the 9th December 1793, by Virtue of a Warrant bearing date the 15th April 1792. Granted to Samuel Miles, and re-surveyed for Isaac McKinney the 31st March 1837. Containing Two hundred and sixty nine acres of two perches &c, being the remainder of the Miles Survey, after deducting 164<sup>Ac</sup> 118<sup>Per</sup> allowance taken by the prior survey of George Fry, Esq
