



Situated on the waters of Gunnings Creek called the Hunters Camp, formerly Cumberland; now Bedford County, containing 32 1/4 acres with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c, Surveyed by Richard Teal D. S. May 20<sup>th</sup> 1765.

Resurveyed for Thomas Drumgoole September 8<sup>th</sup> 1797 on warrant dated March 18<sup>th</sup> 1797 - 3 June 1763.
