



Warrt. dated y^e 1st of June 1733

Surveyed on the nineteenth day of Feb^r 1733 To Samuel Finney a Tract of Land situate on the East side of the River Skulkill near Oley in y^e County of Philad^a. Beginning at Black Walnut standing on y^e East side of y^e River Skulkill being a corner of sa^d ^{Thos. Laurence's} ~~Finney's~~ Land Thence by y^e same North seventy Degrees East three hundred & Ten perches to a post Thence by vacant Land South Twenty Degrees East ninety six perches to a Post thence by Vacant Land South Seventy Degrees West Two hundred and Twenty Perches to a Birch standing on the Bank of y^e said River Thence by the several courses of y^e same to y^e first mentioned corner containing one hundred & fifty Acres with usual Allowance.
