



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> of July following of a certain lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the general plan of said Town Eighty one, and granted to John Arrison, containing in breadth North and South Fifty seven feet six inches and in length East & West Two hundred and thirty feet, bounded Westward by Broad Way, Southward by Lot number Eighty two, Eastward by River Alley and Northward by Gooseberry Alley, as by the general plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
