



Situate on the Canoe Run in Frankstown Township  
 Huntingdon County, containing one hundred acres  
 fifty perches and allowance of six per cent for  
 roads &c for roads &c first surveyed the 22<sup>nd</sup>  
 in pursuance of a warrant to John Davis dated the 5<sup>th</sup> July 1785  
 November 1785, it then contained 236<sup>85</sup> 85 ps & allow<sup>e</sup> -  
 but interfered with older surveys - was resurveyed  
 the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1820. by order of the Board of  
 Property dated the 4<sup>th</sup> April 1820, and the  
 said interferences excluded.
