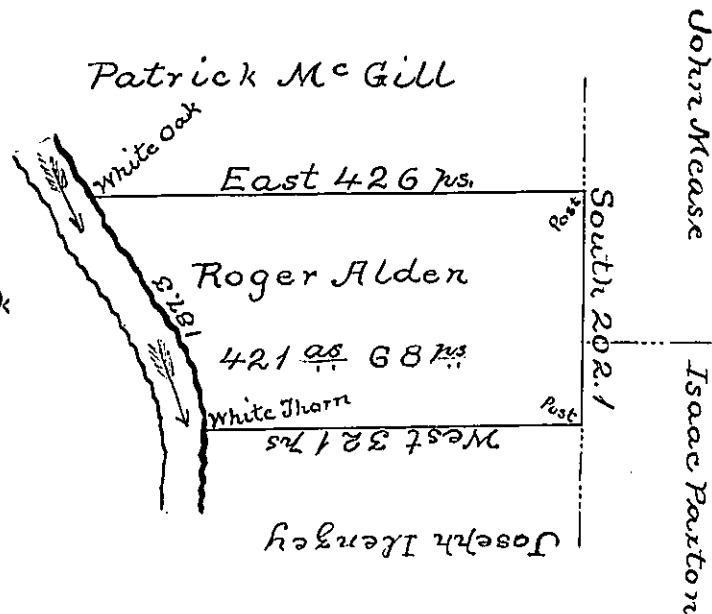

In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 <sup>ac.</sup> dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1801, was surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July 1801, for Roger Alden the above described Tract of land containing 421 acres 68 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate on the East side and adjoining French Creek in Mead Township Crawford County. It being the same tract of land that was surveyed for a certain John Fredebaugh the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794, in pursuance of his Improvement dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1792.
