



The Draught of a tract of Land Situate in Ferguson Township Centre County  
 Containing Sixty Six Acres and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c<sup>d</sup> <sup>Surveyed</sup> the 11th  
 day of June 1812 in pursuance of a warrant Granted to John Batman, Junr and Joseph  
 Gates as Tenants in Common Bearing date the 16th day December 1811.

At the time of making the above described survey John Batman, Jr & Joseph  
 Gates lived on the premises in a small Cabin, had about five or six Acres of Clear-  
 ed land on the same & two or three peach Trees which Appeared to be bear-  
 ing trees - and by the best information I could get the improvement was first  
 made in April 1802.
