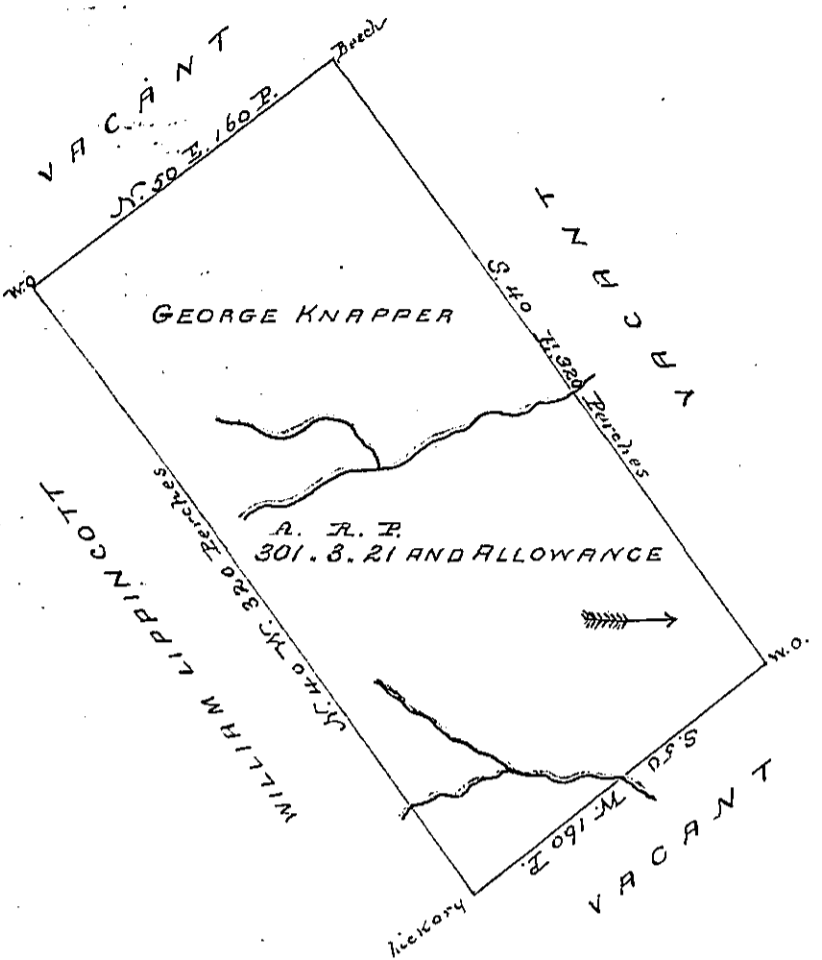


Laid down by a Scale of 100 perches to an Inch.
