



The draught of a Tract of Land, situate on the North side of Juniata River at a place called Crawford's Neck, a few miles from Pack's Narrows in the County of Cumberland. Containing Eighty four acres and usual allowance, proportionate to Six acres p cent. for Roads &c. Survey'd the 31st of May 1765. for Alexander Chambers, in pursuance of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble}. the Proprietaries, bearing date at Philadelphia the 31st. day of May 1762.
