



A Draught of a Tract of Land, known by the name of the Chestnut Land, situate on both sides of the Path leading from Frankstown to the Kittanning about a mile North-west from where the said Path crosses the Chest Creek adjoining Land surveyed for Abiah Taylor in the County of Bedford, containing Three hundred and Eight acres and one quarter of an acre and the usual allowance of Six Percent for Roads &c. Surveyed the twenty-first day of June 1773 for John Hannum in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 25th day of May in the same year.
