



The Draught of a Tract of land situate in the Ferguson Township, Center County, containing Sixteen acres, One hundred and fourteen perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 1817 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Glen dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 1815.

The improvements on the above described tract of land, at the time of making the survey, consisted of a cabbin dwelling house & a stable, about two acres of cleared land, a family actually residing thereon under James Glen. Said to be first improved the first of December 1801.
