



A Draught of a Survey called "The Alteration" situate in Pitt Townships Allegheny County (formerly Westmoreland) containing 191 ac. 123 yds. & 2/3 usual allow. for Roads &c. executed Decr. 9<sup>th</sup> 1803. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Wm. Powell for 300 acs. dated Decr. 24<sup>th</sup> 1784.

Note. it appears that a survey of 307 acs. was made of the land on the same Warr<sup>nt</sup> by Benj. Lodge Esq<sup>r</sup> on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1785. and this survey is made for the purpose of quieting interfering claims on older rights
