



Situated on the waters of Dumfries Creek called the Hickory Bottom formerly Cumberland now Bedford County containing 305 1/4 Acres with the allowance of six p^r. Cent for Roads &c (being one of the Tracts within the Boundaries of a large Survey made for George Croghan May 22^d. 1766 by Robert McKense under Richard Lee D. S.) Resurveyed August 18th. 1797. On Warrant Dated June 3^d. 1763.
