Draught of a Tract of Land, situated on the Waters of Gentle Creek in Wilkins Township, Allegheny County, Pa. Containing One Hundred and twenty five Acres forty eight perches & five eighths of a perch, together with an allowance proportioned at six per cent. for Roads & Highways. Being part of a larger Tract of land originally surveyed by William Thompson, D.S. the 5th day of June 1770. in pursuance of an order, dated the 3rd day of April 1769. No 2182 granted to a certain Caspar Mackenselder. Duly the 24th October A.D. 1850 for Christopher E. Sully.
