



Draught of a Tract of Land. Situated on the Waters of Tunkle Creek
in Wilkins Township, Allegheny County, Pa. Containing One hundred
and twenty-five Acres forty-eight perches or five eighths of a perch,
together with an allowance proportioned at six per cent for Roads
& Highways. Being part of a larger Tract of land originally sur-
veyed by William Thompson, D.S. the 5th day of June 1770. in
pursuance of an order dated the 3rd day of April 1769. no 2182
granted to a certain Caspar Mackenselde. Surveyed the 24th
October A.D. 1850 for Christopher C. Seely.

the river till it reaches a point at the distance of 8.44 perches from the P.O. on the
line N10 W continued northwardly, and he therefore claims the same to be the line till that
