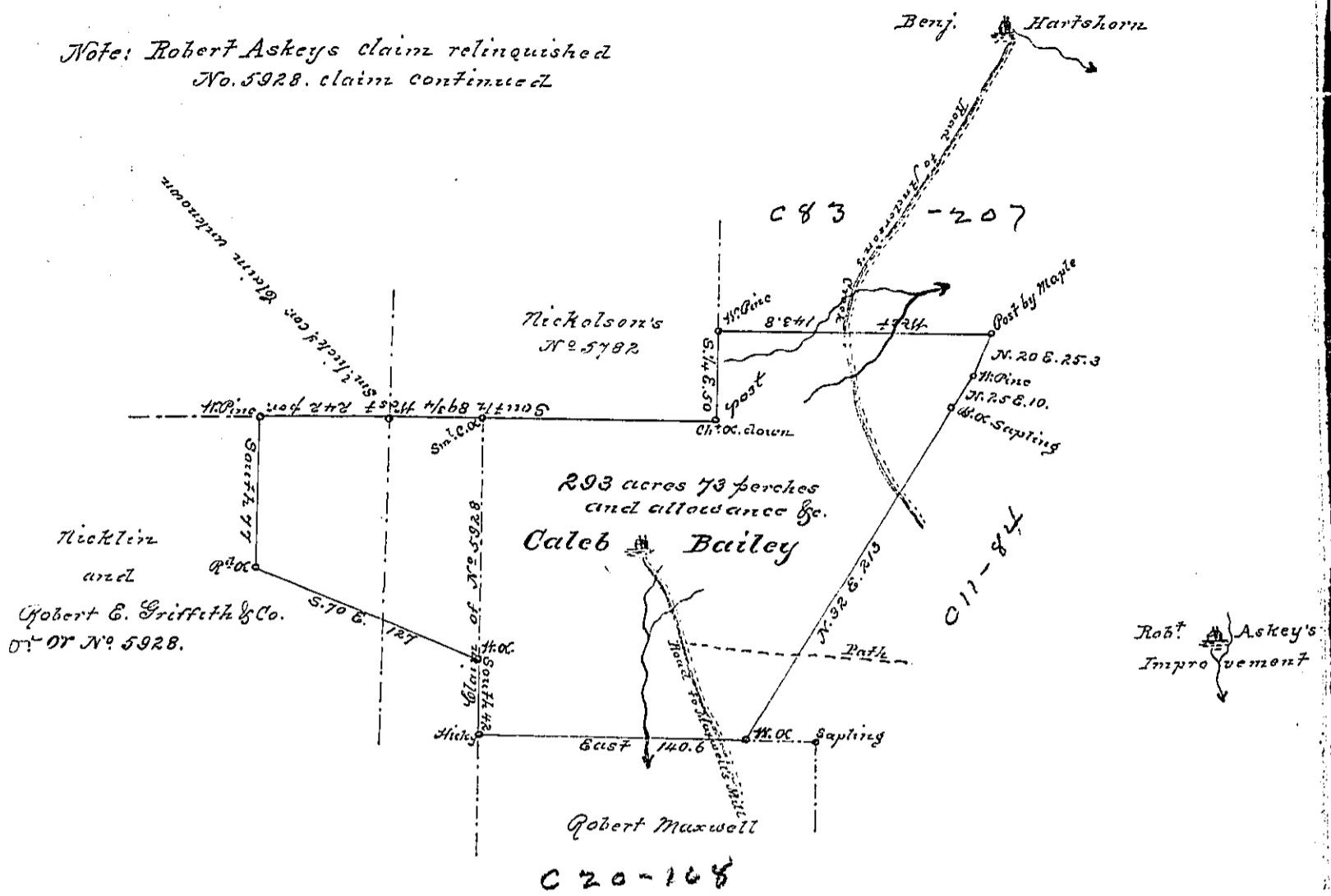


Note: Robert Askeys claim relinquished  
No. 5928. claim continued



Situate about two miles North West of the mouth of Andersons Creek now in Chingliclamush township in the County of Clearfield; adjoining lands of Nickolson's No. 5782, Nicklin and Robert E. Griffith No. 5928. Robert Maxwell, Robert Askey, and Benjamin Hartshorn; containing Two hundred and Ninety three acres and seventy three perches and the usual allowance for roads &c. Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> of February 1810 for Caleb Bailey, including his improvement, in pursuance of a warrant dated the 14<sup>th</sup> of September A. D. 1809 containing then 407<sup>ac</sup> 97<sup>pt</sup> &c. and by surveying again a division line between Benj. Hartshorn and Caleb Bailey, the 21<sup>st</sup> of May 1810 in obedience to an Order of the Board of Property dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of April 1810. Baileys improvement commences the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 1805, and his actual settlement in Spring 1807.
