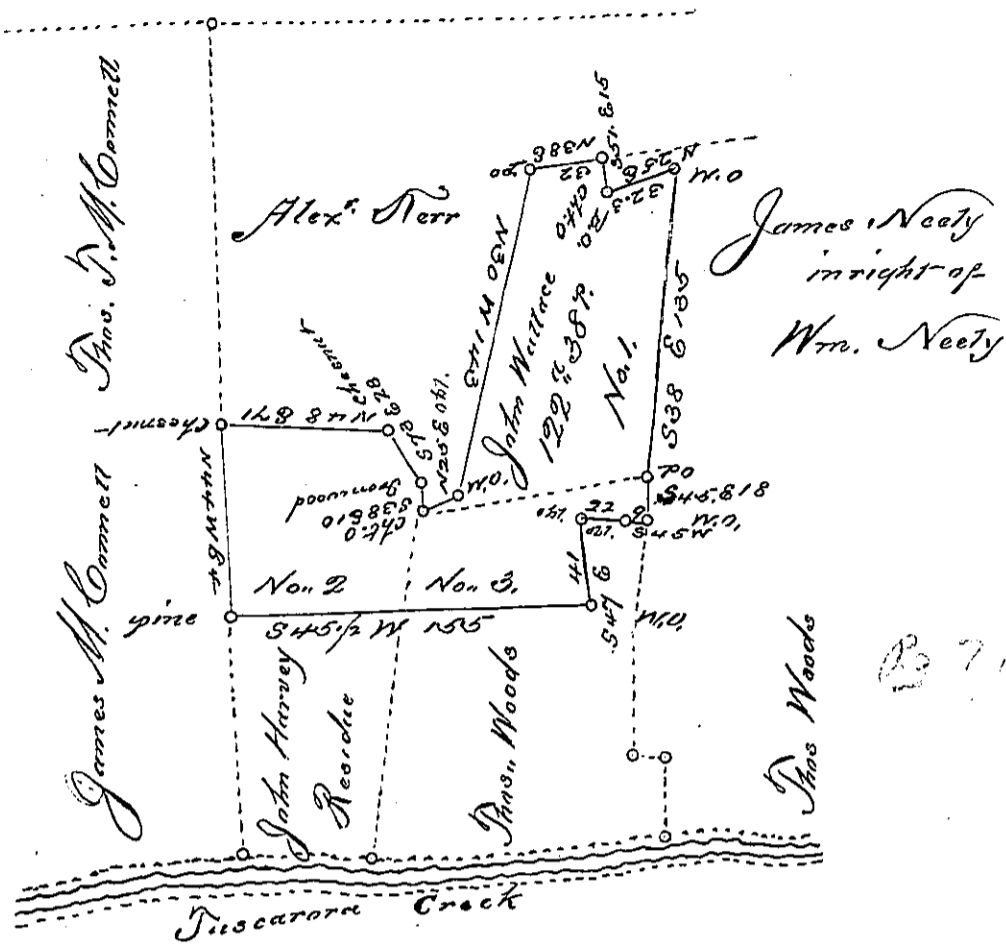


James M. Cully

Draught of one hundred and twenty two acres and thirty eight perches of land with six per cent allowance. Situate in Dissected Tack township Juniata County, being composed of part of three several tracts. No. 1. Is a tract which appears surveyed in pursuance of a warrant to John Wallace dated May 24th 1755 and said to contain 61 acres and 123 perches. No. 2. Is part of a tract said to contain 8 1/2 acres, surveyed April 2nd 1740 upon an Application by John Harvey No. 4216 The residue shown by dotted lines. No. 3 Is a part of a tract, Warrant Granted to Thomas Woods dated Febr. 3rd 1755.
