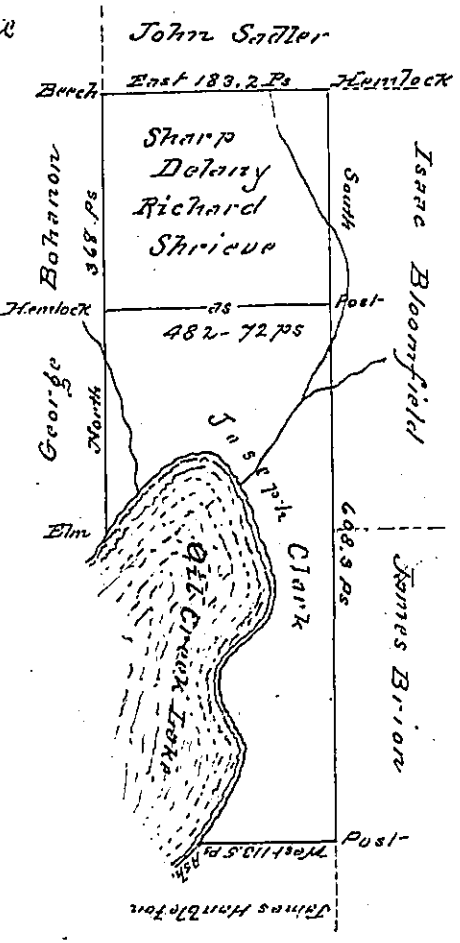

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400. acres dated the 30th day of May A.D 1792 granted to Sharp Delany - was surveyed on the 14th day of June A.D 1817 the above described tract of Land containing, 482 acres 72 perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. situate in Bloomfield Township Crawford County, and at the time of Making the same, Richard Shrieve Esquire was Residing thereon with his family and there was Built a House fit for the Habitation of man and there appeared Cleared fenced and in a good State of Cultivation upwards of thirty acres of Land, and that the same was Divided as above stated Between the said Shrieve and Joseph Clark -
