



Surveyed the 14th day of April A.D. 1830 by Samuel Gulton Esq., the above described tract of eight hundred and ninety four acres & eight tenths & allowance of six percent, Situated in Ridgeway Township Jefferson County, East of the Allegheny River and Conawango Creek last purchase made of the Indians by Warrant, ^{Granted} dated the second day of October 1793 numbered four thousand two hundred and sixty seven, and approved this 23^d day of June A.D. 1831 by
