Notiz: - this Survey is disputed by Eripen Brownfield who has procured and order of Survey for the same in the name of Robert Perry N<sup>o</sup> 3167 dated 24<sup>th</sup> April 1769 and first transfer<sup>d</sup> to Mr. Paul & then by him to Brownfield I attempted to make a survey of the land in 1771 but was prevented by Carr who has since procured a Warrant & the 1771 so agreeing. I have now Surveyed it for Carr in Order to lay it before the Honble Board to determine the right of Mr. Carr.
