Wilson King Deputy Surveyor of the County of Erie do hereby officially certify and make known <sup>noted in the survey</sup> that the above is a true copy of a Draught and the annexed notes of a Survey, Book kept by me and that at the time of Surveying the same to said Nathaniel Ethridge was actually residing on and engaged in improving the farm and from the Books or Documents in my Office the said Land does not appear to have been appropriated to any Person other than the said James Culbertson or Nathaniel Ethridge in pursuance of Culbertson's Settlement. Except that a Survey has been made on the South End covering the whole to the dotted line for James Dougherty and Henry Pole now claims to the same line in pursuance of all account in the name of Barnabas Scully
