Situated Part in Chester County and Part in New-Castle County Beginning at a white oak by a branch of Nannans Creek then N. E. in the Line of Robt Cloud & Robt Brown 317 Perches to a black oak in Bethel Line thence N. W. in y^e Line of Robert Pils 100 Perch. to a small black oak thence S. W. by W 78 Perch to a white oak thence W. N. W. 38 Perch to a white oak thence S. W. by S 134 Perches to a white oak by Nannans Creek thence Down S^d Creek S. 5. E. 7. 0, S. 6. W. 2. 0, S. 1. 0. E. 5. 8, to first mentioned white oak.
