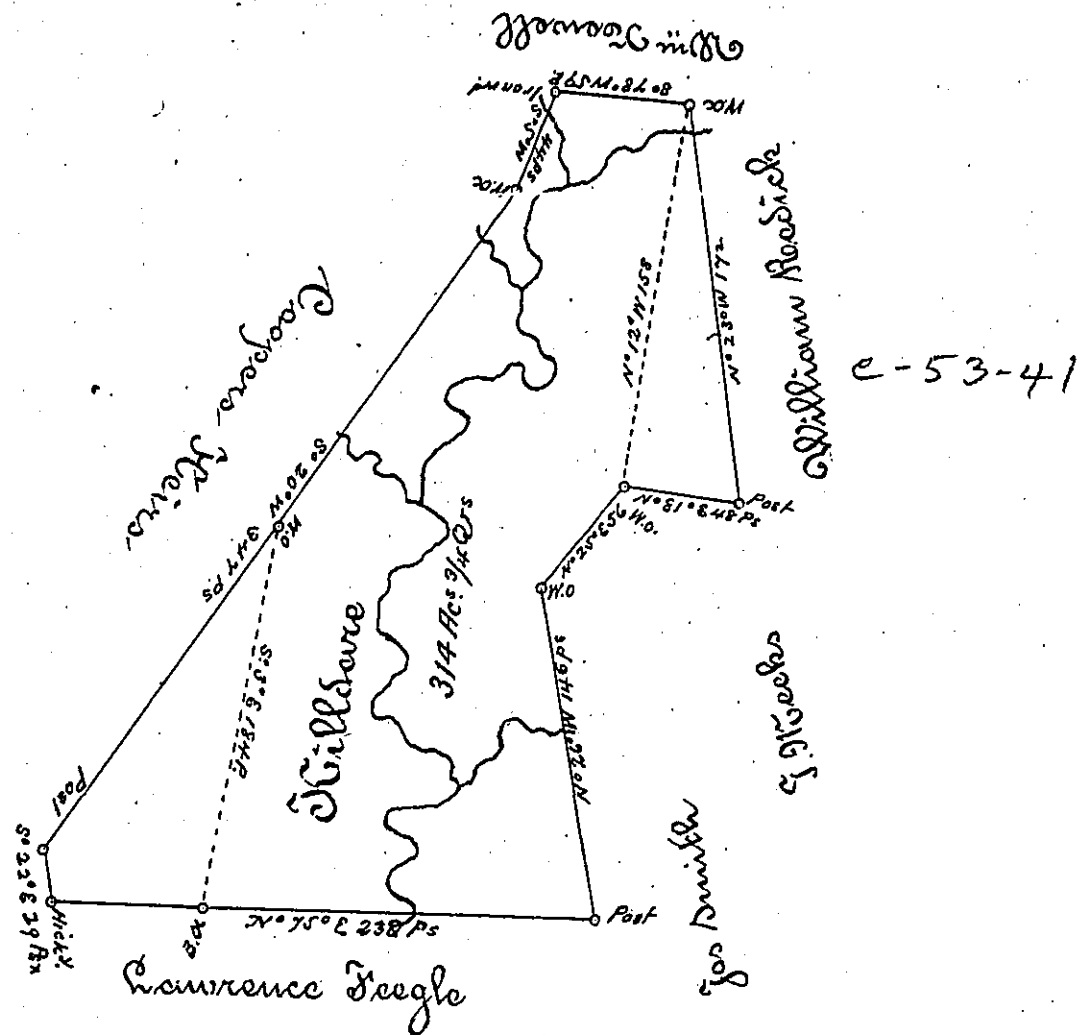

Note, the Warrant is dated The 29<sup>th</sup> March 1785.

On ye 15<sup>th</sup> of June 1785 a survey was made on a Warrant in the name of Jno Wilson for 500 Ac. dated the 10<sup>th</sup> of Febry 1785, and forwarded to the Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> Office the 17<sup>th</sup> August following - the survey then made contained 205 Ac. 2 R<sup>ts</sup> 37 P's and was agreeable to the above Draught exclusive of the two Segments laid off by the dotted lines - In 1788 Jno Wilson first complain'd to me that his Survey was not full, and desired a Resurvey. I told him I could not do it as his Return was made, and the adjoining Surveys closed without a special Order for that Purpose he then complain'd to the Sur<sup>r</sup> Genl of my conduct. I explained the Matter to him, he highly approved of my conduct, and informed me I might indulge Jno Wilson with a Resurvey, noting the alteration for the information of the Board the Segment on the N<sup>o</sup> East is part of a Survey made for Jno Redick after Wilsons first Survey. that on the S<sup>o</sup> West I am instructed is claimed by the Heirs of a certain - Cooper - the Resurvey contains 314<sup>9</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Acs and was made A<sup>pl</sup> ye 17<sup>th</sup> 1788 but not call'd for till now
