It was then said to Contain 194^{ac} & 102^{sq}. The black Lines in the above Diagram represent a tract of Land first Surveyed the 15th day of ~~Sept~~ December 1805 & resurveyed the 3rd of Nov: 1830 In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Michael Walk. Dated the 19th day of March 1789. The piece Marked with the Letter A Contains 48 Acres & allowance &c And shows how much the Survey in the name of Michael Walk Interferes with the Survey in the name of E. Nichols. The above Diagram laid down by the Interferences Ascertained the 17th day of Jan'y 1831 from an Actual Survey made upon the ground In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property Dated the 14th of December 1830
