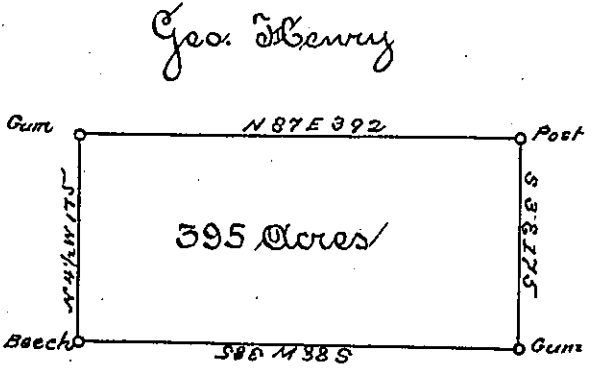

The above is a draught of a survey made the 15th day of Novem^r 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Kirkbridge Willner dated the 18th day of March 1794 situated on the Waters of the Peachanock branch of Beaver Creek in the ^{2nd} ~~third~~ donation district, in Allegheny County containing three hundred and ninety five acres and allowance of six ^{second} ~~third~~ Centum GC called Virginia
