



Agreeably to a survey made the 1st of April 1798 by James Harris Esq. then the Deputy Surveyor of this District the above Draught contains one hundred and fifty Acres, fifty three perches and allowance of six per cent &c. Being part three hundred and eighty three acres of land surveyed to Daniel Simpson the 13th day of March 1775 by virtue of an Application to him dated the 3rd day of April 1769, Numbered 478 and subdivided as above represented - Done the 30th 1810
