



Situate in the East end of Nippenose valley in Nippenose Township in the County of Lycoming. Resurveyed for Charles Pryor the 26th day of October 1809 in Pursuance of an order from the Board of property (without date) and found the lines marked all round. Except the line adjoining Daniel Toy agreeing with the former Survey containing Three Hundred and Fifteen acres and forty eight perches and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c
