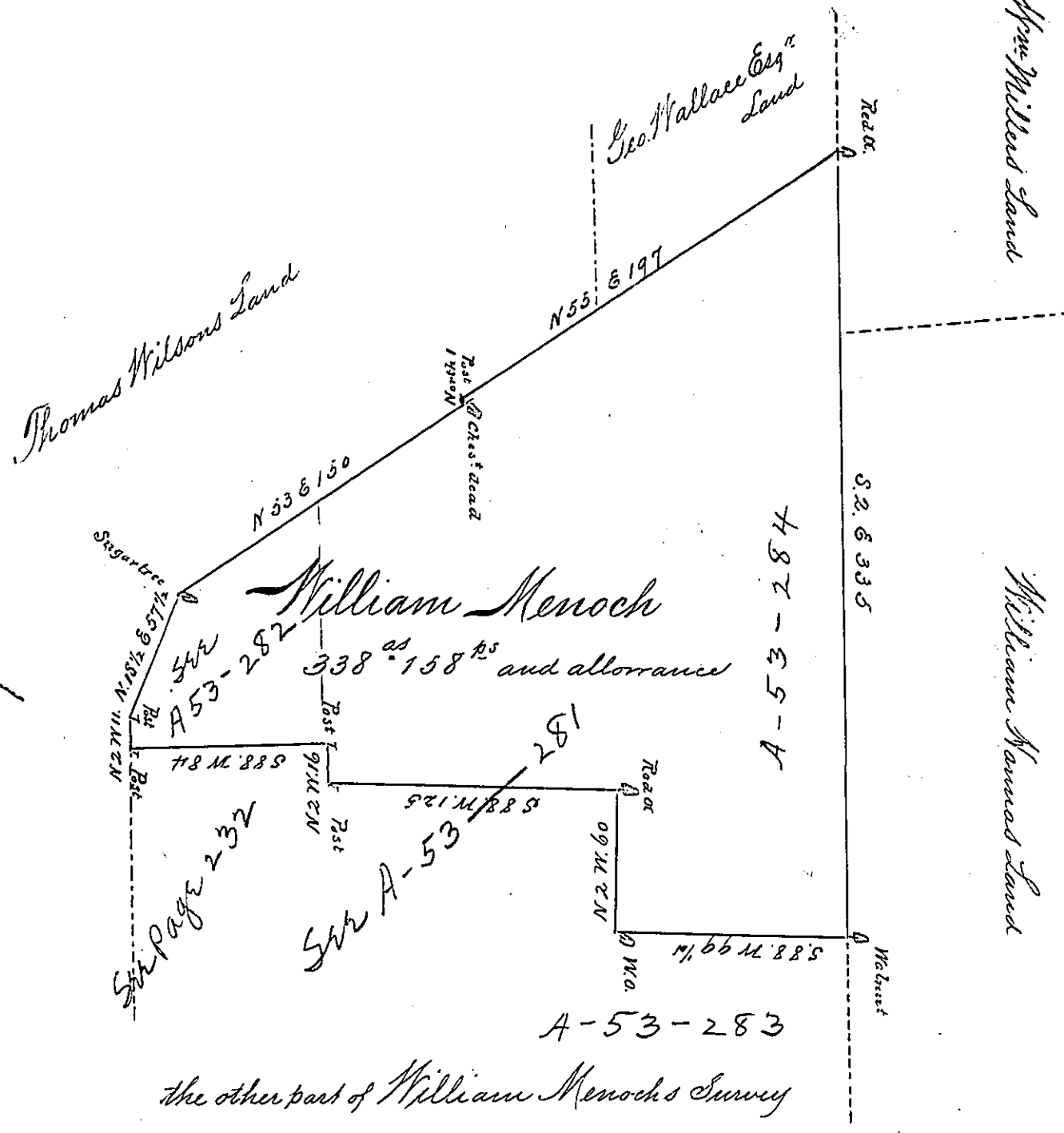

Whereas Robert M. Crea D.S. did on the 20th day of April 1770 Survey to William Menoch in pursuance of two orders viz N<sup>o</sup> 493 & N<sup>o</sup> 2761 a certain Tract of Land containing five hundred & seventy eight acres situate on Forbes's Road about eleven Miles from Pittsburgh and Whereas I have been requested to divide the same Land so that each of the present owners may obtain a Patent for their respective Share agreeable thereto the above described Tract containing three hundred & thirty eight acres and 158 perches with the usual Allowance of Six p. Cent. being part of the Survey before mentioned was on the 29th October 1798
