 Field Notes of General Thompson which he left upon record, and the lines and Marked  
 Trees corresponded with the same, but it is entirely comprehended within two late surveys,  
 one on a Warrant in the name of James Guffey the other on a Warrant for George Henry,  
 which Surveys were made by James Sample late D. Secy who has the Warrants  
 in his possession Benj. Lodge
