



A Draught of a Tract of Land called "Ballentog" situated on the Westernly Side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River, above & adjoining a Tract of Land surveyed for Andrew Allen Esquire, opposite to the Mouth of a Creek called Lahawanack & an Island called Lahawanack Island, in the County of Northampton, Containing three hundred & eighty seven Acres, besides the usual allowance of 6 P. Cent for Roads &c.
