Surveyed on the 12th July 1813 the above described tract of land containing three hundred and ninety nine acres one hundred and forty two perches and eight tenths and allowance of 6 P^{er}ch.

Situate in Ripon Township, Lycoming County and bounded as above described. The improvements are a small house with a family residing therein, a small stable and about twenty acres of land clear?
