N<sup>o</sup> 2 represents part of a survey made for Edward Bell on warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of May 1830. This tract interferes one hundred and fifty one acres and one fourth acres with the Andrew McNeally tract. Edward Bell is the present owner not paid.
