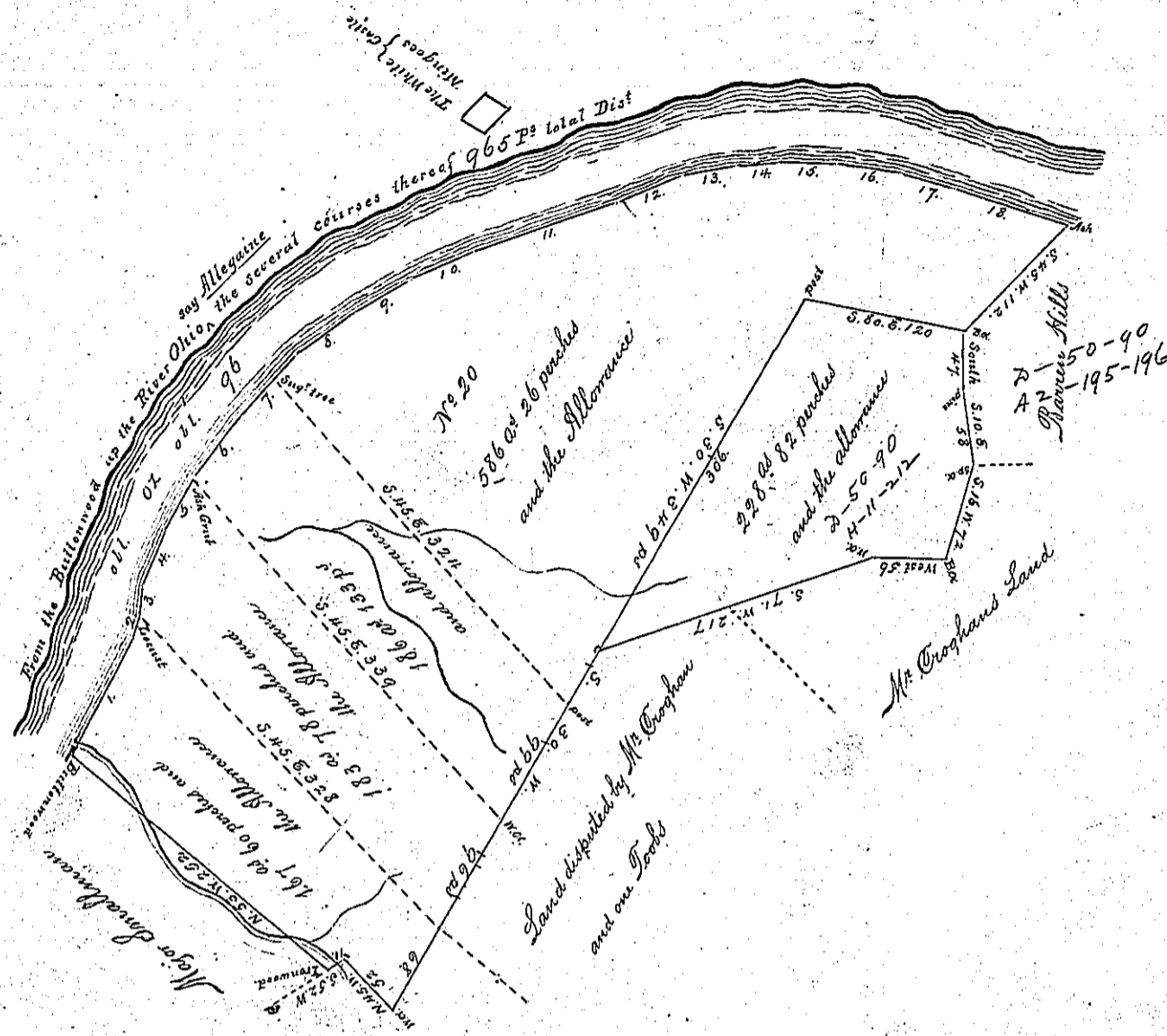

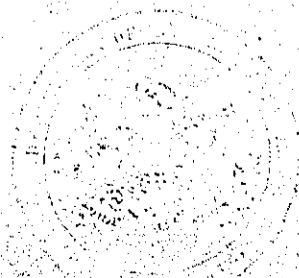

Otherwise Containing in the whole Thirteen Hundred & fifty two Acres and 39 perches with an Allowance proportioned to 6 per cent. Situate on the River Ohio from the mouth of the two mile Run up to the Narrows Including several of his Improvements &c Surveyed the 26 & 27<sup>th</sup> of June 1769.
