



A Draught of a tract of land situate in Willingborough Township Susquehanna County containing two hundred and eighty acres and twenty nine perches and allowance of six per cent for roads said to have been surveyed to Abraham Dubois for Jacob Wart an assistant to Anthony Crothers Esq^r late Deputy Surveyor in the month of October 1794 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 13th day of June 1792 - - By an Examination on the Ground the 20th day of January 1815 and by the traverse of the river since taken the Survey as above stated appears to have been made

N.B. The above described tract of land is the same on which Jonathan B. Newman ^{now lives} and for which he obtained an improvement Warrant dated 16th May 1815 stating his Improvement to have commenced the 1st March 1809 - He claims by the same lines courses and distances as taken on examination July 4th 1815 It is also my duty to state that when the above was made out a Suit of Ejectment was pending in Susquehanna County between the said Dubois & Newman for the Title
