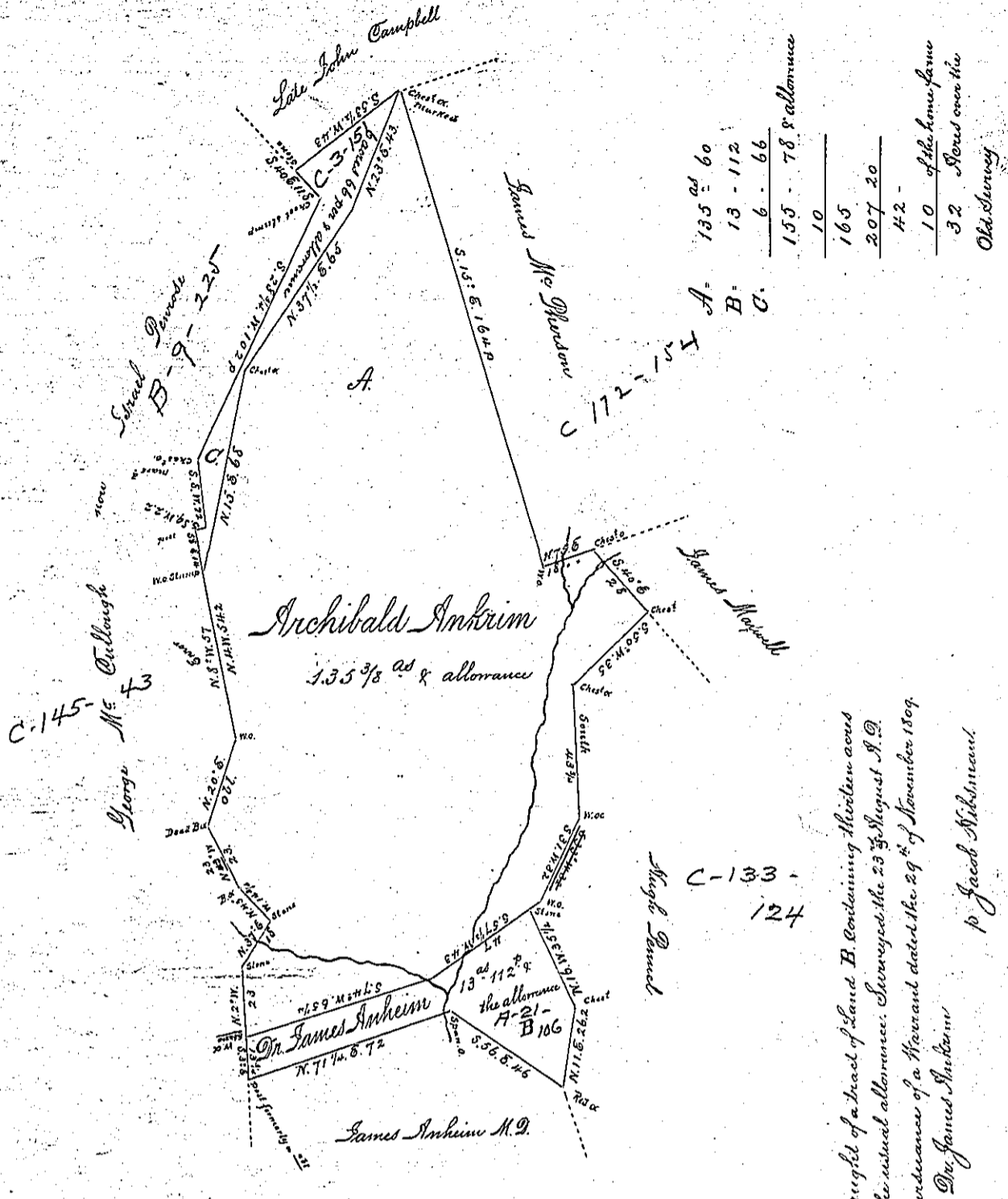

A Draught of a tract of Land A. Situate in Drumore township Lancaster county Containing 135 3/8 ac & the usual allowance of six paces for Roads &c. Survey'd the 28<sup>th</sup> day of Ap<sup>l</sup> A.D. 1790 for Archibald Anheim by virtue of a Warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1766.
