



In pursuance of a Warrant Bearing Date the first day of June 1763. By Order of the Surveyor General; me at the Request of Captain Harry Gordon. Assisted by Major James Livingstone an Captain Lemuel Barret; who shewed me the Land: I did on the Ninth day of June 1766 Survey for Captain Thomas Basset; the above Described Tract of Land situate on Ewells Creek; And on the North West side of the Ragged Mountain and adjoining the Provincial Line; <sup>in Cumberland County</sup> containing Nine Hundred and Eighty Two Acres & One Hundred & Thirteen Perches & the usual Allowance of Six p<sup>ts</sup>. Cent for Roads. Samuel Finley
