



The above Drafts (including all within the black Lines) describe a Parcel of Land situate in Washington Township in the County of Franklin (formerly in Antium Township and County of Cumberland) containing in the whole one hundred and fifty five Acres and fifty two Perches and the Allowance of six p. Cont for Roads &c. Surveyed April 1st 1789. at the Instance of Nicholas Bittinger, who claims the same under a Warrant granted to Jacob Orrall bearing Date the 8th Day of June 1762. — Since making the above Survey, found an original Draft of a Survey of 115 3/4 Acres & Allowance in the Name of Samuel Cunningham including all that Part of the present Survey lying Southeastward of the red Lines, and which is disputed by said Bittinger
