



Situated on the dividing ridge between Youghiogheni and Monongahela River in Rostraver Township Westmoreland County & Surveyed the 22^d day of March 1786. In consequence of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners appointed to adjust the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Yohogania Monongalia and Ohio of which the following is a true copy — We the Commissioners for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania & Ohio do hereby certify that Andrew Pearce is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania situate on the waters of Monongalia to include his settlement made in the Year 1702. Given under our Hands at Coles Fort the 12th February 1780 & in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
