



Situated on a small Branch of Redstone Creek in the New Purchase Cumberland County and surveyed Sept<sup>r</sup> 13<sup>th</sup> 1769 for Samuel Lyon Junier By Order of Survey N. 3352 Bearing Date the 12<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1769. But an Order of Survey in the name of Henry Boyles N. 2107 & dated the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1769 - after ward appearing and the said Henry Boyles requesting the same to be executed this Return is made in consequence thereof

Note. a Caveat was entered about two years ago against the acceptance of Lyon's Survey by James Finley Assignee of Henry Boyles & said Finley is now in Possession of the same N.B. it was alleged that the dispute was settled by s<sup>r</sup> Finley's purchase of Lyon's right
