



Plan of a Tract of land situated in Guilford Township Franklin County containing Three hundred and sixty three acres & twenty three perches and the usual allowance of six p Cent for Roads &c. &c.

- A. A Tract containing One hundred & twenty four acres and forty four perches & allowance of six p Cent for Roads Surveyed May 12th 1768. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted Henry Thompson Dated 27th March 1751.
- B. Containing Two hundred and four acres & forty six perches & all being part of a Tract of two hundred & eighty eight acres and seventeen perches. Surveyed May 12th 1769 On a 0th and Granted John Thompson Dated the 14th of June 1760.
- C. Containing Eighteen acres & Eighty six perches & allowance
- D. Containing Eleven acres & sixty seven perches & allowance. Being parts of a Tract of One hundred and ninety seven acres and allowance of six p Cent for Roads. Surveyed November 4th 1766 In pursuance of a Warrant Granted John Thompson Dated the 9th September 1766.
- E. A Triangle containing Four acres and one hundred & twenty one perches & allowance. Extending to the Mark line there being no mark^d trees on the course of the Old Survey
