N^o 1 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Robert Shaw on Warrant dated the 10th day of September 1762 - This tract interferes Two hundred and eighteen Acres with the James Dalton tract - Robert Shaw conveyed to William Peters who conveyed to Ludwick Lyberger the present owner.

N^o 2 represented by dotted lines is part of A Draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Ludwick Lyberger by virtue of a Settlement Commenced in 1788 - This tract Interferes Twenty four Acres and twelve perches with the James Dalton survey - Ludwick Lyberger is the present owner.

N^o 3 represented by one dotted and the lake Colored lines is part of a Draft of A tract of Land surveyed for Joseph Woods on Order N^o 353 dated the 1st day of August 1766. This tract interferes Twenty three Acres with the James Dalton survey - Joseph Woods conveyed to John Traser who conveyed to Simon Gratz and Levi Phillips who lost the Land at Law with Ludwick Lyberger who claimed on a Settlement, who now owns the Land.

N^o 4 represented by dotted lines is part of A Draft of a tract of Land surveyed for William Shaw on Warrant dated the 10th day of September 1762. this tract Interferes Eleven Acres and one Hundred and six perches with the James Dalton survey - William Shaw conveyed to William Peters who devised the same to Richard Peters who conveyed to Jonah Robbison who conveyed to Cornelius Martinis who conveyed to Adam Miller who devised the same to Josiah Miller Esqr the present owner

 N^o 5 represented by the red and dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Marcus Metzgar on Warrant dated the 9th day of June 1791 - this tract interferes fifteen Acres with the James Dalton Survey - Marcus Metzgar conveyed to D^o William Cathcart the present owner
