



In pursuance of a Warrant dated March 22nd 1787 & also in obedience to an Order from the Honourable Board of Property dated January 7th 1788 there was Survey'd to John Correll the above described Tract of Land containing Four Hundred Acres & 115 perches with an Allowance proportioned to six p. Cent. Situate on the Waters of Thompsons Run adjoining Land of Thomas Sands Christian Linheart & others in Pitt Township in the County of Westmoreland Survey'd March 8th 1788.

N.B. the above described Land was Survey'd & returned to the Suror^y Gen^l Office by Cap. obb dqr for Widow Correll but no entry appearing in y^e Suror^y Gen^l Office she applied for a Warr^t in her obb m for Corrells name — Jacob Skiller has a Warr^t dated Feb 13th 1786 which appears to be for the same Land but he has not attended and it appears they both claim under Improvements
