



The Draft of a tract of Land situate in Newton Township Cumberland County containing one hundred & seventy four acres & one hundred twelve perches & allowances (with the addition of the 12 perches) It being part of a Larger Survey made on a warrant granted to James Kilgore Dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of April 1752. Surveyed and Divided off the 20<sup>th</sup> August 1793. The above is a true copy of the original (all but the 12 perches addition) delivered over to me by my predecessor Dan<sup>l</sup> Henderson Esq<sup>r</sup> as an office paper.
