



Situated on the East Branch of Dunning's Creek "Called Dorans Run" (formerly Cumberland) now Bedford County, containing 736 Acres & 15 perches with the allowance of six p^{ts} Cent for Roads &c (being one of the Tracts within the Boundaries of a large Survey made for George Croghan May 22nd 1766 by Robert W. Kensie under Richard Tea D.S.) Resurveyed August 31st 1797. On Warrant Dated June 3^d 1763 granted to John Little George Woods D.S.

A Survey in the Name of Ephraim Williams made July 28th 1786. on Warrant dated Aug^t 22^d 1785. Interferes with the above Survey.
