I find that the said Land conveyed on a Warrant and demands the surplus land to be paid for the same on the return of Henry to the Land Office and being acquainted with the said of the said in the said of my showing (with a return) made on a Warrant granted to me on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1827. Having myself at that time till a Warrant for said surplus land was taken out of the said office by John Smith on which a Warrant has been executed by the Sheriff of Northumberland County on a part of said surplus land to said John Smith, now known to me by the name of Smith. I have given quiet claim to all that part of the surplus land conveyed to the said Henry and granted to said John Smith and am willing to comply with said Act of Assembly whereunto as Henry has not my hand & seal to this same Warrant of the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 1830.
