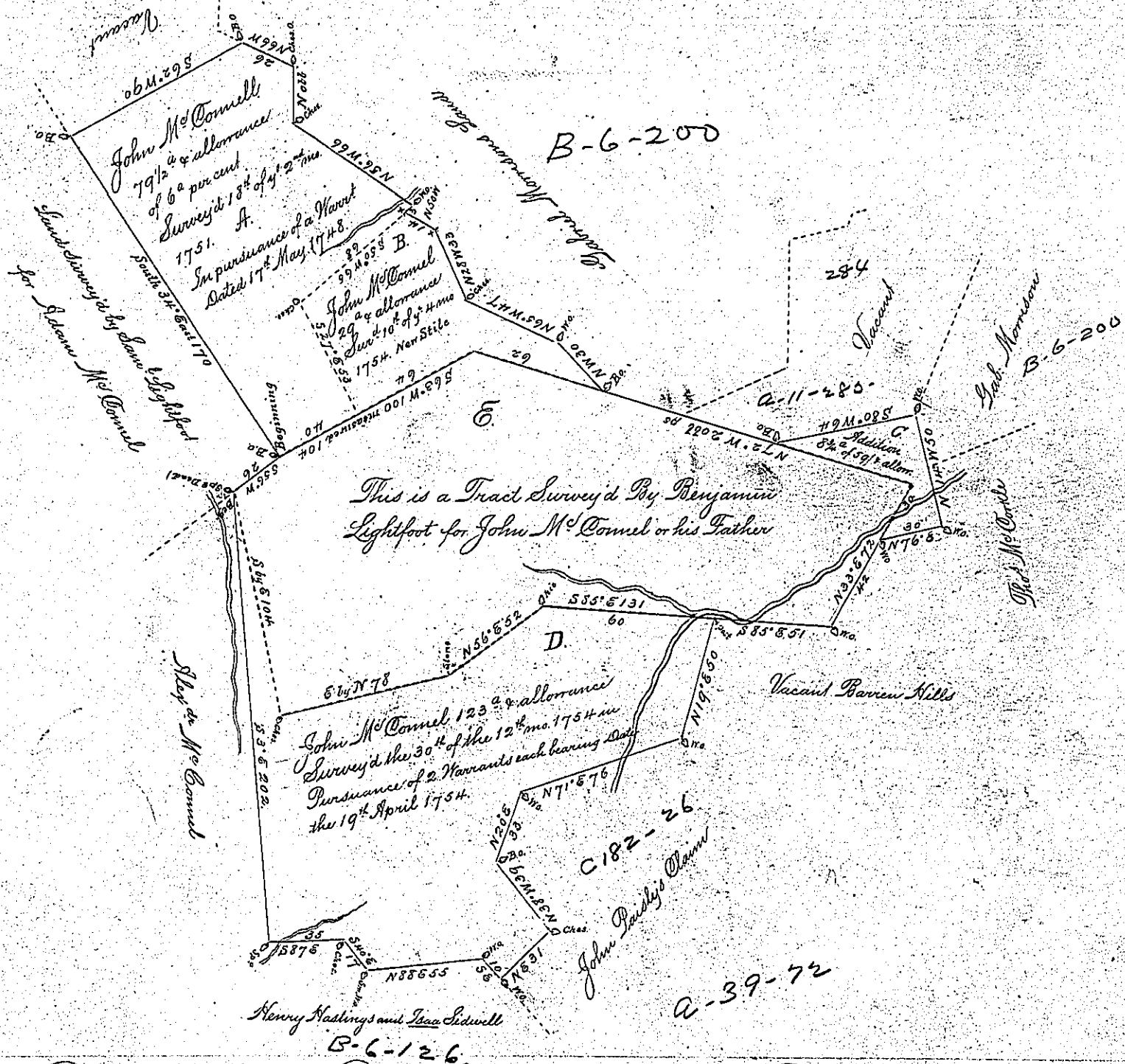

This is a Tract Survey'd By Benjamin Lightfoot for John M<sup>c</sup>Connell or his Father

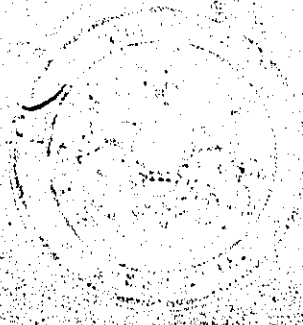
The Land Described by this Draught is Situate on the Branches of Octoraro Creek in Colerain Township Lancaster County
