



The above described Tract of Land was originally granted to James Logan by Warrant for 300<sup>as</sup> dated 9<sup>th</sup> day of February 1733 which was afterwards vacated & ordered to be surveyed for Samuel Campbell by order from Richard Peters Secretary dated 12<sup>th</sup> of Feb'y 1741. Surveyed 24<sup>th</sup> of Feb'y 1784. for John Campbell & Thomas Campbell containing in all 292-3-311<sup>P</sup> & allowance Situate in New London Township in the County of Chester certified
