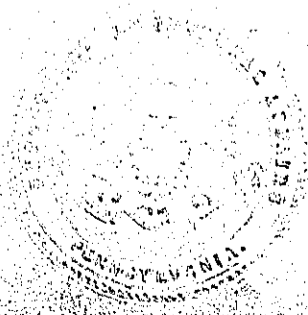


A Draught of a tract of Land situate in Shrewsbury Township York County surveyed for Thomas Curry including three other tracts belonging to said Curry, viz<sup>t</sup> two made by John Churchman one on a Warrant for 25<sup>a</sup> dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1748. Granted to James Carr and assigned to said Curry the other for 50<sup>a</sup> dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of August 1749 granted to John Orr and assigned to said Curry the other survey made by Thomas Armon on a Warrant for 50<sup>a</sup> granted to said Curry dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of ~~the~~ <sup>January</sup> 1757 which survey also includes another Warrant granted to the said Curry for 50<sup>a</sup> dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of July 1762. Containing in the whole 397<sup>a</sup> 113<sup>p</sup> and allowance of 6 per cent. Surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the 3<sup>d</sup> mo<sup>th</sup>: 1766
