Situate in Liberty Township Adams County Surveyed Nov-11th 1820 as represented by the black lines, in pursuance of an order of Resurvey granted to William Long dated Nov. 3rd 1820. It represents the residue of the original tract not included in the other surveys which was surveyed June 2nd 1791 for Jacob Woekersmith & Christian Smith by warrant dated April 21st 1788 B & C are the vacancies mentioned in the order of Resurvey & D is a small piece which I believe to be vacant containing 1^a 1^{ps} & all the whole containing one hundred & seventy nine acres & allw. E & F are parts of the original survey, which are agreeable to the lines of a large Maryland survey called Carolina as established included in it G is the part ^{included} in Patrick Reeds survey & N is a part of the original survey included in Samuel Caldwell's Survey
