That part where the letter A, is placed in the above diagram represents part of a larger Tract of 303^{ac} & 79^{ps} and allowance &c. Originally surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 21st of the 3^d month 1766. for John McCleary In Pursuance of a Warrant for 200^{ac} Granted in the name of William Orr dated the 17th day of November 1762. And that part where the letter B, is placed in the above draught represents part of a larger Tract of 222^{1/2}^{ac} & allowance of Land Originally surveyed by the said Mathews on the date above mentioned. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 200^{ac} Granted to John McCleary dated the 25th day of November 1762. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tracts of Land on the 5th day of December A.D. 1810. for and at the request of the owner David Anderson who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation the 17th day of March 1812.
